Jack's brother, William, joined him in 1945 when the business was moved to Chestnut Street. A devastating fire necessitated a move nearby and the business expanded to a retail operation, eventually adding a second store in Cherry Hill in 1971 and a third, located in Haverford in 1989. The Philadelphia store moved again to Walnut Street in 2003.

In recent years, Jack's son Jim and his sister Diane Young operated the business with Jim's sons, Dan and Jeffrey. They decided to close their Cherry Hill store in 2007 but were concerned about running a liquidation event...until Jim contacted Wilkerson and Associates.
